

# Czechia



The Czech Republic (short name Czechia) is situated in Central Europe and shares its borders with Germany, Austria, Slovakia and Poland and is an important tourist destination. It offers visitors not only a multitude of historical landmarks but also diverse natural sites such as mountains, ponds, caves and spas with mineral springs. The capital city of Prague is one of the most beautiful cities in the world, with an unforgettable atmosphere of a metropolis whose history spans a millennium. Other regions of the country, not just the capital, also offer countless museums, galleries and landmarks.

Czechia and its capital offer many protected cultural monuments, castles, chateaux, cities and villages. Some of them are on the UNESCO list of world cultural and natural heritage sites: in addition to Prague's historic centre and Průhonice Park, there are also Český Krumlov, Telč, Kutná Hora, the pilgrimage church of Saint John Nepomuk at Zelená hora, the Lednice-Valtice cultural landscape, the gardens and castle in Kroměříž, the south Bohemian village of Holašovice, Litomyšl – Renaissance castle and historic city centre, Olomouc – Holy Trinity Column, Brno – villa Tugendhat, Třebíč – Jewish Quarter and St. Procopius Basilica, the Krušnohoří Mining Region and the National Stud Farm in Kladruby nad Labem.

## Public Transportation

### From Prague Airport to the City Centre

- **BUS 100** direction to terminal station **Zličín**, change to **Metro Line B**. Tickets are purchased from ticket vending machines at airport bus stations, CZK 30.
- **BUS 119** direction to terminal station **Nádraží Veleslavín** (Veleslavín Railway Station), change to **Metro Line A**. Tickets are purchased from ticket vending machines at airport bus stations, CZK 30.
- [Special BUS line AE](#) departure from Terminal 1, direction to terminal station **Hlavní nádraží** (Main Railway Station), change to **Metro Line C**. Special fare – tickets are purchased from the driver, CZK 100.

Tickets are available for purchase at vending machines located at all metro stations and some tram and bus stations. Tickets need to be **validated**. Validators are installed in metro vestibules before entering the metro and on board trams and buses.

## Okolí stanice metra ' The Metro Station Area Map

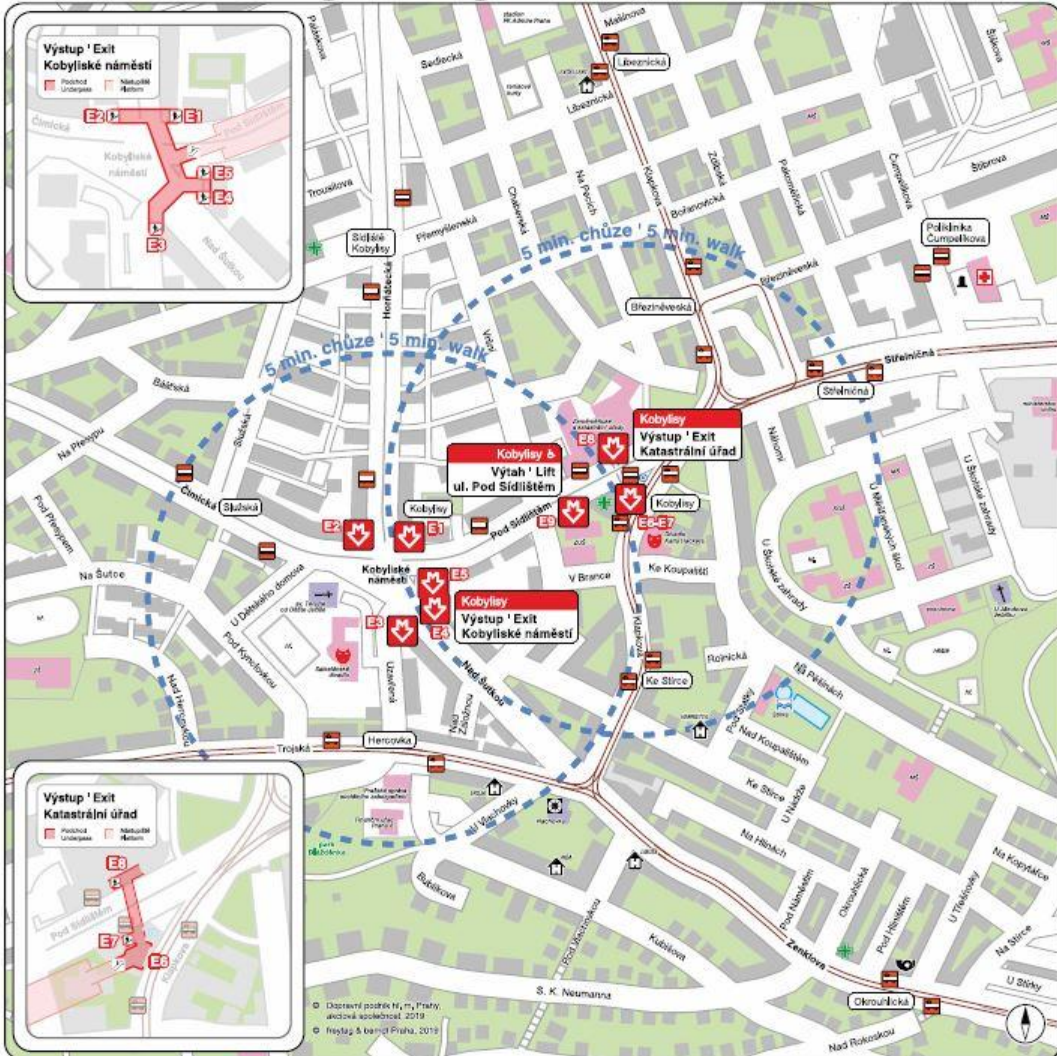
